What is the St. Mary's Comprehensive MS Clinic?

Multiple sclerosis is a complex neurologic disorder affecting the brain and spinal cord causing unpredictable and sometimes long-lasting symptoms.

The comprehensive multiple sclerosis clinic provides a comprehensive evaluation through a variety of healthcare professionals including a neurologist, MS certified physical therapist, occupational therapist, and speech therapist.

This group of providers will assess any limitations in gross or fine motor movements, balance or any cognitive deficits as well as managing MS treatments.

Patients spend 45 minutes with each provider for a comprehensive evaluation of their current MS symptoms.

When and where is the clinic?

The clinic is provided once a month on Wednesday mornings from 8am-11am at St. Mary's Auburn Campus on the second floor.
